

## Install the Yoroi Wallet browser extension on a computer, laptop or tablet

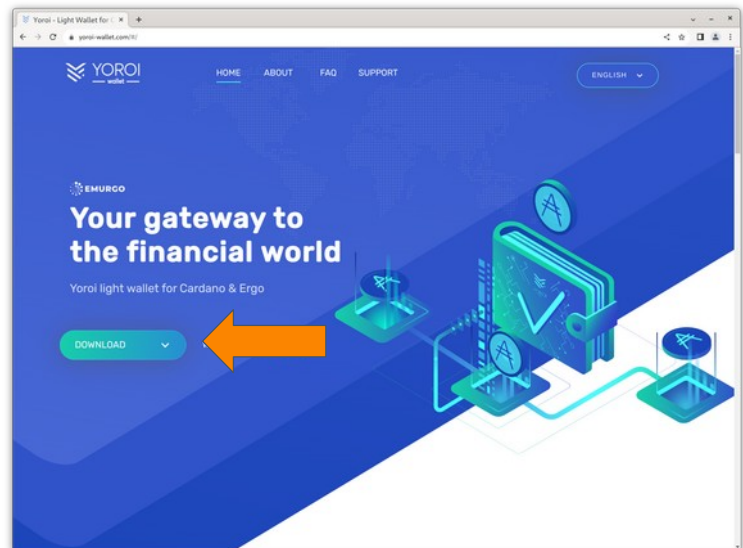
Follow the steps to install Yoroi in your favorite web browser.

Yoroi is also available for your iPhone or Android phone.

Download the Yoroi Wallet via the [App Store](#) or [Play Store](#) and start this guide with step number 7.

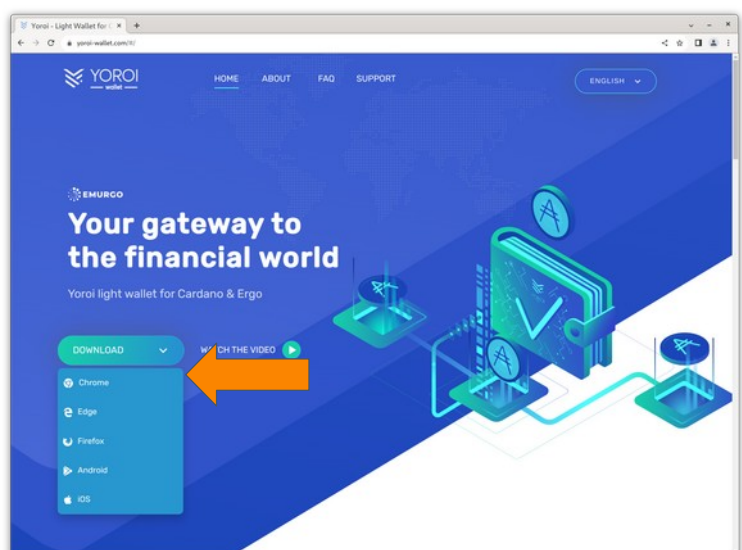
- 1 Navigate to <https://yoroi-wallet.com>

Click on the "Download" button and choose your browser from the list.

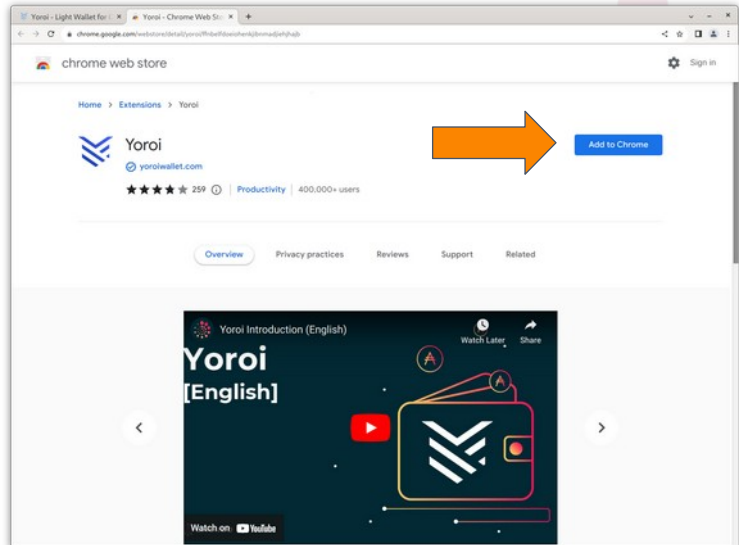


- 2 In this guide we're using Chrome/Chromium, so the button will take us to the Chrome Web Store.

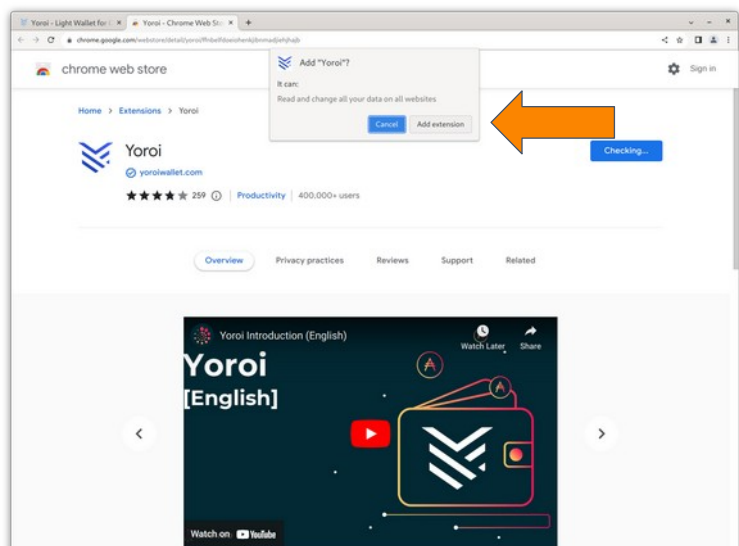
When you're using a different browser, the following four steps might be slightly different.



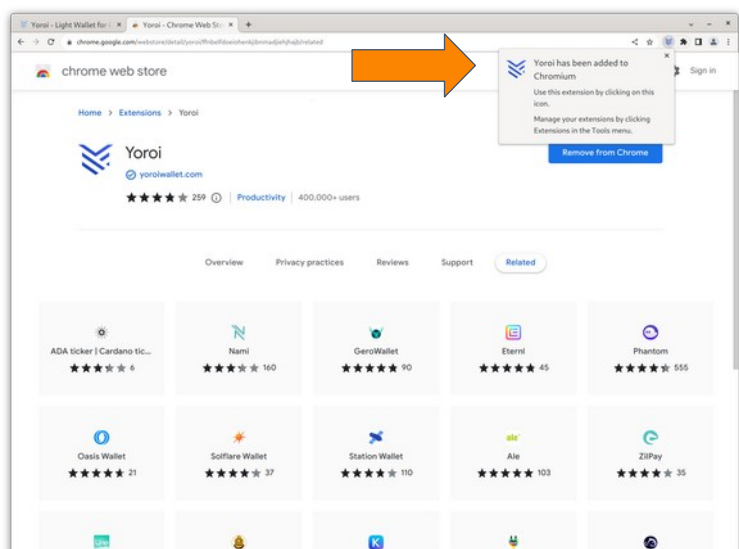
3 In the Chrome Web Store, click the "Add to Chrome" button.



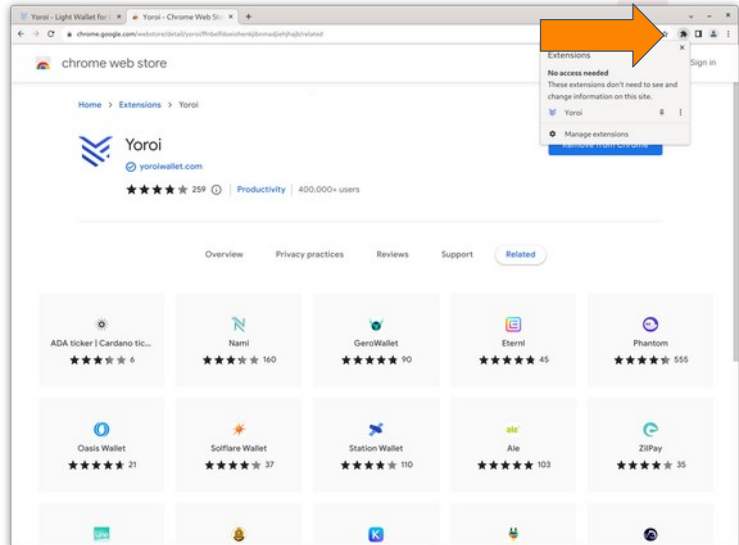
4 Chrome will ask you to install the browser extension, so click "Add extension".



5 You will see a confirmation that the Yoroi browser extension has been successfully installed.

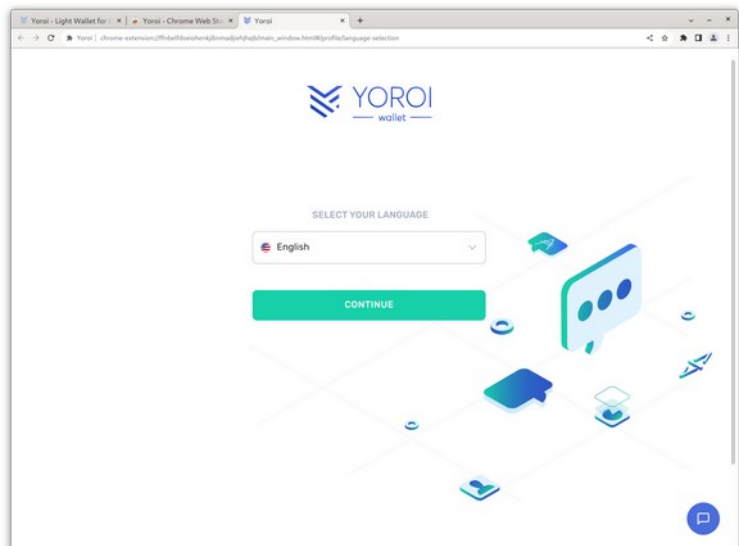


- 6 Click the "Extensions" icon to access a list of all browser extensions and choose "Yoroi" to open your wallet.

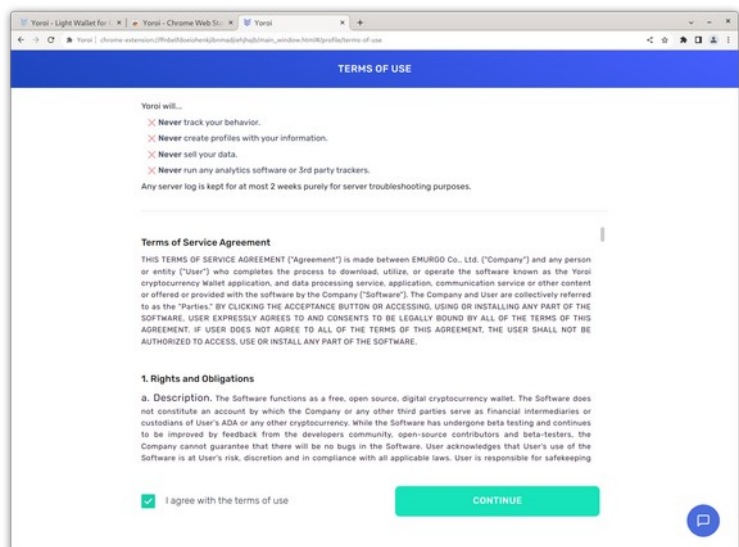


- 7 Before you can use Yoroi you need to set some preferences.

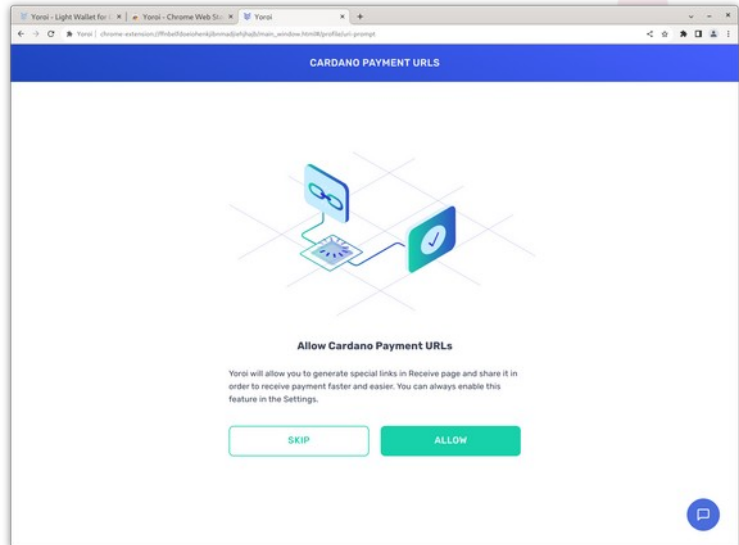
Choose your preferred language from the list and click "Continue". We have chosen "English" for this guide.



- 8 Read the Terms of Use, check the box and click "Continue".

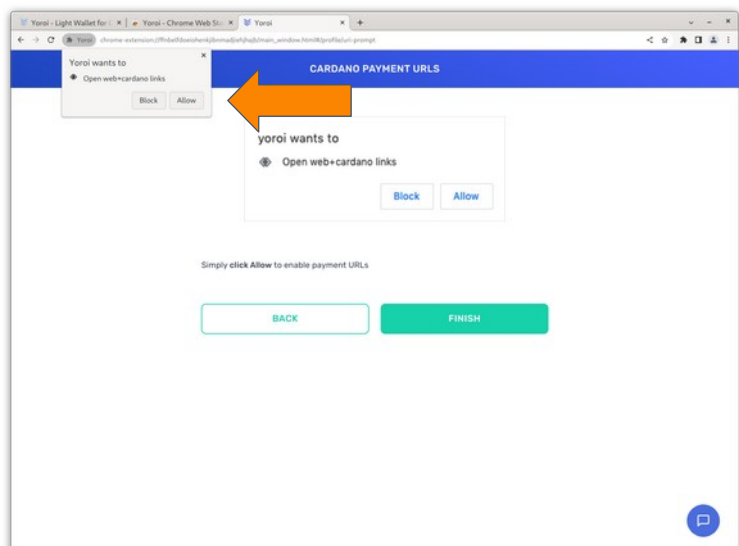


9 Click on "Allow" if you want to be able to easily share your address with others for easy payments from them to you.

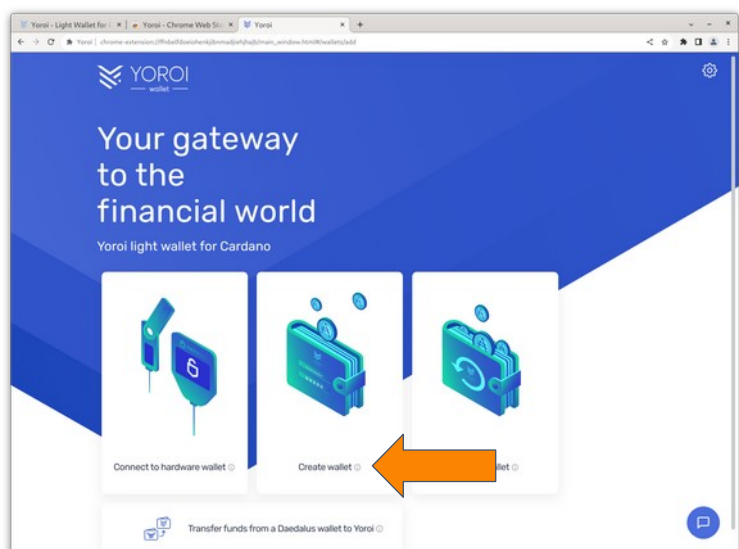


10 Click "Allow" again in the dialog that has popped up to let Yoroï Wallet handle any Cardano links on other websites. Then click "Finish".

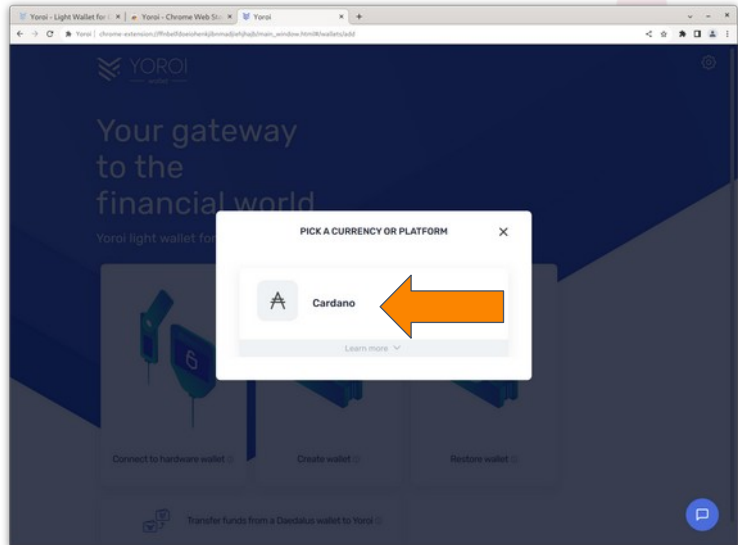
Yoroï is now set up and you can proceed to create your wallet.



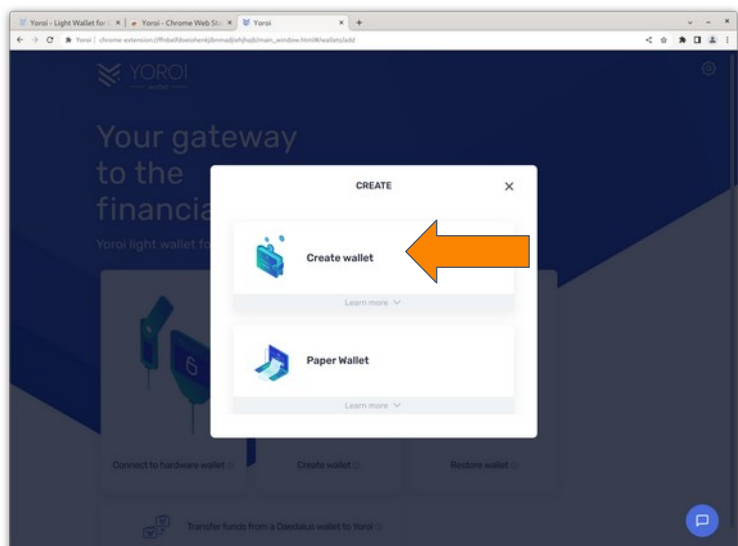
11 Click on "Create Wallet" to open a regular wallet.



12 Choose "Cardano" to create a wallet for your ADA cryptocurrency coins.



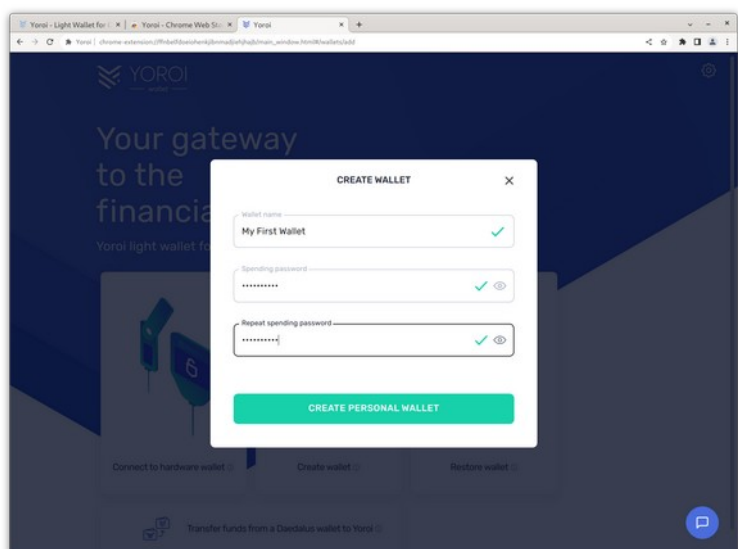
13 Click on "Create Wallet".



14 Choose a name for the wallet and choose a password. The minimum length is 10 characters.

The password is needed when you want to spend ADA. Therefore the password is referred to as "Spending Password". Remember this password!

Click on "Create Personal Wallet" when you have filled all of the fields.

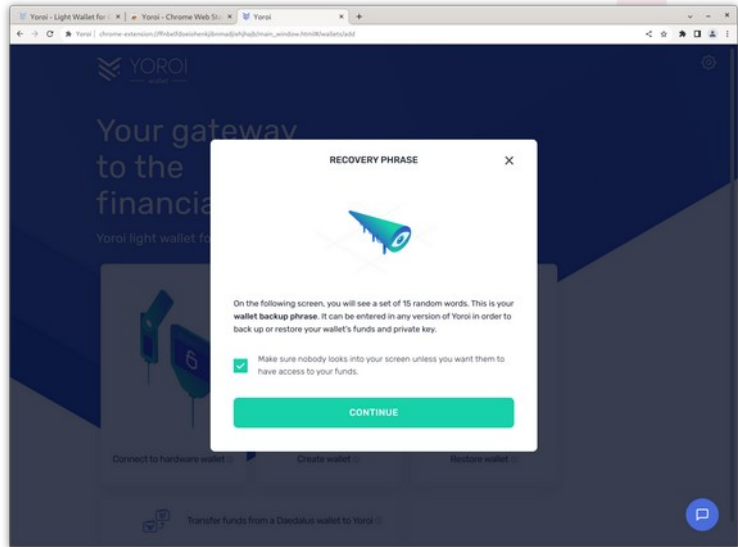




**15** The Recovery Phrase is your wallet's backup. It is needed when for any reason you need to restore the wallet and funds.

Do not share the Recovery Phrase with anyone; those who know it will have access to your crypto.

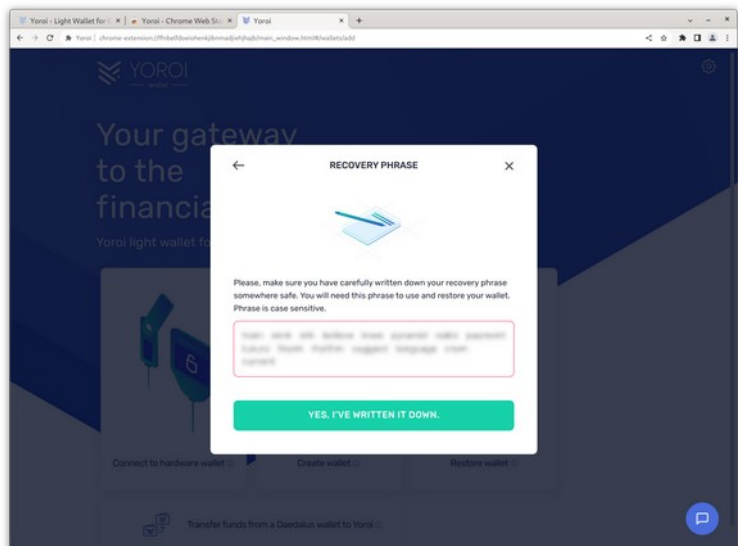
Carefully read all of the on-screen instructions. Tick the box and click "Continue".



**16** Write down your Recovery Phrase (from left to right) somewhere safe and secure.

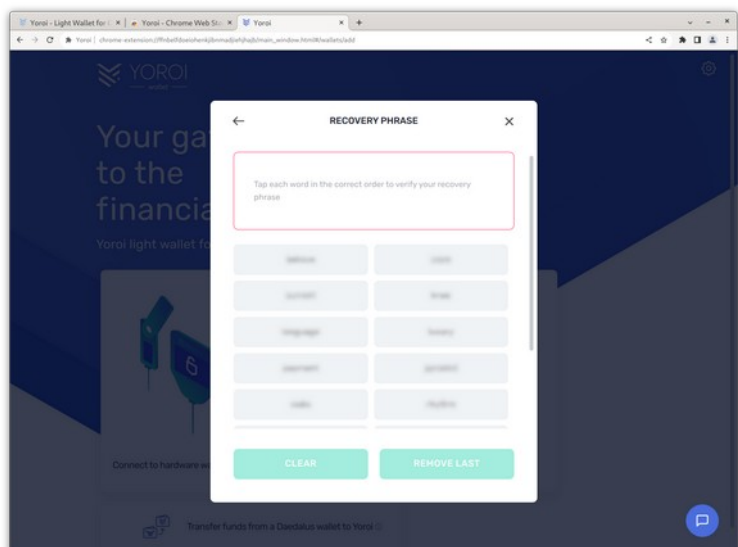
It is recommended to make at least one handwritten copy and store it at a second safe and secure location. Do not store the Recovery Phrase digitally.

Losing the Recovery Phrase means losing your crypto!



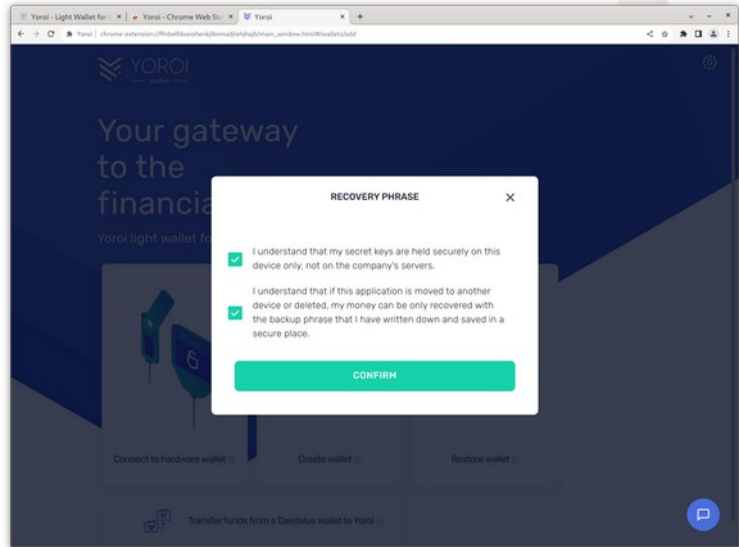
**17** Now that you have written down the Recovery Phrase at least two times, you are going to make sure it's correct.

After clicking all the words in the correct order you will be automatically taken to the next step and you won't be able to recall your Recovery Phrase from the wallet anymore.



18 Read the paragraphs and tick the boxes when you have understood the information, then click "Confirm".

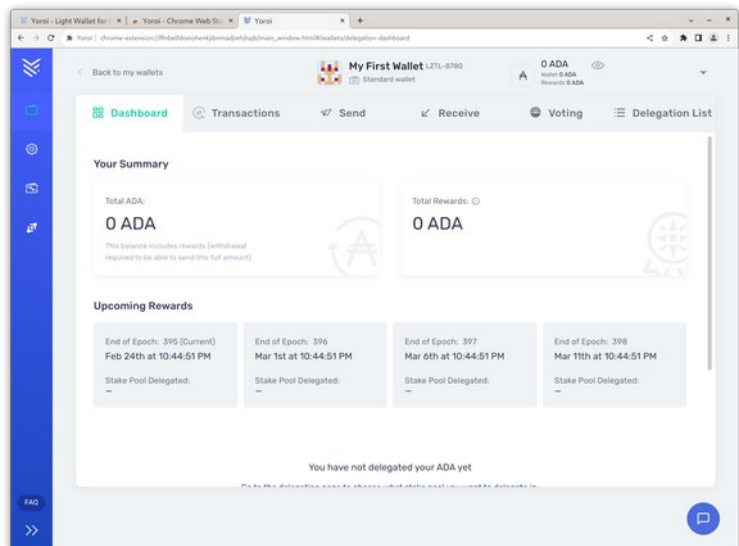
Congratulations! Your Yoroï wallet is now ready for use.



19 This is how your new Yoroï wallet looks.

From here you can connect to dApps, participate in the Cardano voting process and delegate your ADA to a stake pool.

20 You can access your Yoroï wallet at any time by clicking the "Extensions" icon next to the address bar. This will open a small window and from there you can access Yoroï.
